

Quick Guide to Pattern Mixing

1. Match at Least One Color



When mixing patterns
try to keep at least
one coordinating color
between the two patterns.
This helps give some
continuity to your outfit
even though the patterns
are different.



2. Vary Your Pattern Print Sizes



Mix up your pattern sizes.

Do either a large print
bottom and small print
top or vice versa. If your
prints are too similar in
size the eye won't know
where to go first.



3. Follow the Formula



Every pattern falls into a category of being either busy and complex or clean and simple. When in doubt follow this formula when pairing your patterns and you can't go wrong!

Simple + Complex or Simple + Simple



Bonus: Stripes are a Neutral

In the world of pattern mixing think of stripes as a neutral. Their clean lines and simple pattern allow them to be mixed with just about anything!
